



Competencies, skills, and learning outcomes derived from assessment-based, non-degree activities and align to specific, timely needs in the workforce.

Description of the course/qualification/credential.

Skills

A list of the most relevant skills that the learner has achieved competence/appropriate standard in by undertaking this course/qual. Each skill is individual and if the learner clicks on one of those skills it will take them to a job site to show what jobs are available with the skillset that they have learned in their area.

Earning Criteria

This could be describing assessment components that the learner has had to achieve, the type of independent checks, quality assurance.

Micro-Credentialing



Micro-Credentials: NZQA definition

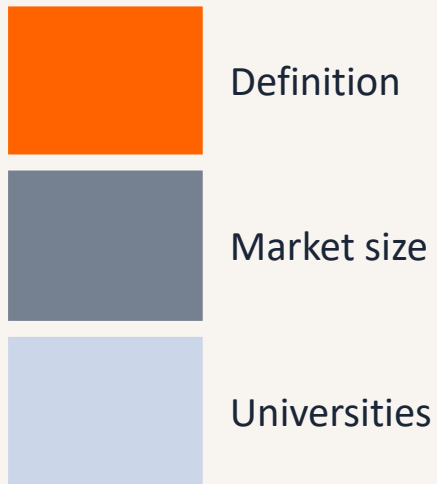
A micro-credential certifies achievement of a coherent set of skills and knowledge; and is specified by a statement of purpose, learning outcomes, and strong evidence of need by industry, employers, iwi and/or the community.

They are smaller than a qualification and focus on skill development opportunities not currently catered for in the regulated tertiary education system.

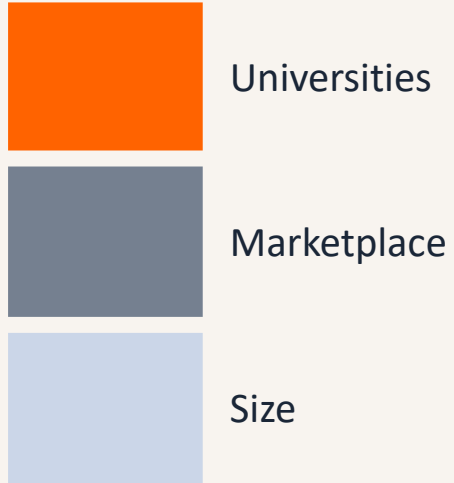
At a minimum, micro-credentials will be subject to the same requirements as training schemes or assessment standards and will also be required to:

- be 5–40 credits in size
- have strong evidence of need from employers, industry and/or community
- not duplicate current quality assured learning approved by NZQA
- be reviewed annually to confirm they continue to meet their intended purpose.

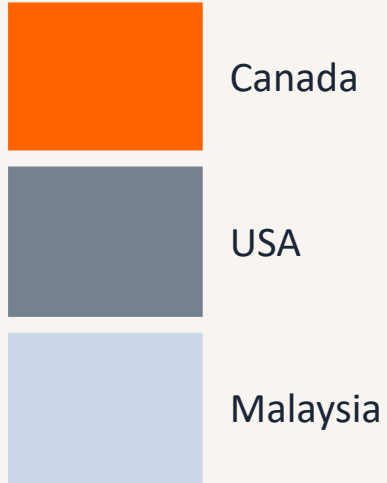
